



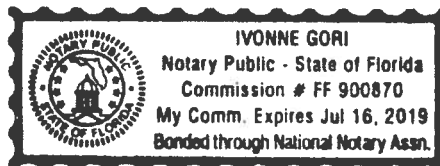

The LRTP identifies highway, transit, pathways and other transportation projects in Collier County that are needed and are expected to be cost-feasible over the next 25 years.

A. CALL TO ORDER

The January 17, 2017, Regular Board Meeting of the Quarry Community Development District was called to order at 11:02 a.m. at the Golf Lodge at the Quarry located at 8950 Weathered Stone Drive, Naples, Florida 34120.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Naples Daily News* on October 3, 2016, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2016/2017 Regular Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

It was determined that the attendance of the following Supervisors constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting:

D. CONSIDER APPOINTMENT TO BOARD VACANCY

Glenn Hollrah was appointed to Seat #5 on a **motion** made by Mr. Rex, seconded by Mr. Demovsky and passed on a vote of 5 to 0.

Mr. Brooks was advised by Mr. Haber that he could participate in discussions, but he could no longer vote since his seat was now filled.

E. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

There were no additions or deletions to the agenda.

F. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

Mr. Thomas of the Quarry HOA presented a report (attached hereto) that included photos. Mr. Demovsky asked if there were addresses for the respective photos and Mr. Thomas responded that there were not; that it was a small sampling of issues and more photos would be presented in the future. Mr. Evans indicated that there may be places that need to be looked at, but these photos were taken before restoration. Mr. Demovsky referred to one of the pictures and asked if the lining should be under the grass. Mr. Evans stated that there is no question that there has been some erosion and that you will have maintenance issues. Mr. Thomas stated that he believes there are tears in the underlayment and rocks have been placed on top. Mr. Rex stated he would like to go look at the area with Mr. Evans. He indicated that he had several issues he would like Mr. Evans to address, including the 10 foot ledge, walking the area with him, verify designs, re-surveying, seeing the letter from SFWMD that the area is certified, Granite Court fix, the seawall at Harbor Hideaway and Spinner Cove, the erosion at the golf course and the beach installed at 9131 Crystal Court. Mr. Radler stated that the property at Crystal Court had already received a violation notice from the HOA. It was the consensus of the Board that Mr. Haber send a violation notice to 9131 Crystal Court.

G. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. November 15, 2016, Regular Board Meeting

The November 15, 2016, Regular Board Meeting minutes were presented for approval.

Mr. Haber noted under Item G1: “Mr. Haber opined that the CDD has the obligation....” The word obligation should be changed to “right.”

Mr. Brooks stated that under the same paragraph, the following sentence: “Mr. Brooks stated that, indeed, Pulte...” should be changed to “Mr. Brooks stated that, indeed, Pulte would have Tomahawk look at the Granite Court house.”

A **motion** was made by Mr. Oldag, seconded by Mr. Demovsky approving the minutes of the November 15, 2016, Regular Board Meeting, as amended. Upon being put to a vote, the **motion** carried 4 to 0.

H. OLD BUSINESS

1. Update on SWMS Repairs, Maintenance and Turnover

Mr. Evans stated that he had not yet received the signed Heritage Bay agreement. Mr. Haber indicated that the Board had approved the form for review with the other board, but that they needed to approve the permits first. He stated that it was premature to have the form executed before the permits are signed, but it was okay to send to Heritage Bay as a form. Mr. Demovsky stated that it was his opinion was to wait until the items previously discussed are fixed before signing. Mr. Rex asked if Pulte is on the hook for all the permits

and Mr. Evans responded that they are not, just the two and SFWMD is aware the permits are being used as a tool. Mr. Rex stated that if the Board does not sign the permits, SFWMD is not going to transfer them and this may result in a contentious process. He furthered that it seems that all these other issues have nothing to do with this signing off process. Mr. Haber stated that he felt that if the Board did not sign and the SFWMD took action, he would need to look into the risk of not signing. He reiterated that Mr. Evans is telling them it has passed SFWMD inspection and that now they need to turn over the permit, which is usually automatic. He furthered that the Board would need to discuss the risk of not accepting the permits if they have been certified by SFWMD. Mr. Rex questioned Mr. Brooks signing permits and Mr. Brooks stated that the Board had given him authorization to do so and that there is no problem with the lake system.

2. Consider Approval of Application Nos. 040212-21 and 070806-9 for South Florida Water Management District Permit No. 11-02234-P for Conversion to Operation Phase

Given the discussion on the previous item, Mr. Demovsky suggested this item be brought back to the next meeting. A **motion** was made by Mr. Rex, seconded by Mr. Demovsky to table this item until the next meeting. Upon being put to a vote, the **motion** carried 4 to 0.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Information on Properties that the District Pays Property Taxes

Mr. Demovsky stated that this issue had come up when reviewing checks for approval. Ms. Dailey explained that there are a number of properties that were turned over and are being reviewed as to their tax exempt status. Mr. Brooks stated that the Pulte attorney had reviewed them and indicated that all are part of the stormwater system and need to be removed from the tax roll. Mr. Haber added that property owned by the CDD for a public purpose should be exempt from having to pay property taxes. He indicated that he would send the proper forms to SDS to have them removed from the tax roll.

J. ENGINEERING REPORT

There was no Engineering Report at this time.

K. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Ms. Dailey stated that they would swear in the new Board Member at the next meeting and go through the organization process.

L. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

The Board thanked Mr. Brooks for his service.

Dear Mr. Radler,

At the January 5th Heritage Bay Community Development District (CDD) Board of Supervisors meeting discussion arose regarding the slalom course that has been installed in the southwest portion of lake 30B. According to a recent inspection this course has been found to be within 100' of the rocky shoreline. As you are aware, boating is prohibited within 100' of the shoreline and idle speed is to be maintained within 200' of the shoreline. The Heritage Bay CDD is extremely troubled about this condition and the safety risk it poses to boaters, skiers, and the District.

We ask that The Quarry Community Association, Inc. enforce the rules and guidelines contained within The Quarry Recreational Lakes & Docks Use Regulations. We further request the slalom course be removed from its current location away from the shoreline. The Board is deeply concerned about the use of the course so close to the rocky shoreline and feel that these steps are necessary for the safety and protection of all.
